

RIGHT TO REPORT

If you, or someone you know, are experiencing sexual abuse or sexual harassment, the Neptune Township Police Department wants to know. We want you to report right away! Why?

- We want to keep YOU safe; it is our job! It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU with relevant information and support services.

HOW TO REPORT

The Neptune Township Police Department offers multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment. Reports can be made anonymously.

- Call the Monmouth County Prosecutor's Office at (732) 431-7160.
- Report to any staff, volunteer, contractor, or medical or mental health staff.
- Submit a grievance or a sick call slip.
- Report to the PREA coordinator or PREA compliance manager.
- Tell a family member, friend, legal counsel, or anyone else outside the facility. They can report on your behalf by calling (732) 431-7160.
- You also can submit a report on someone's behalf, or someone at the facility can report for you using the ways listed here.

VICTIM SUPPORT SERVICES

The Neptune Township Police Department has partnered with Monmouth County Prosecutor's Office to provide survivors of sexual abuse with emotional support services. To access these services, contact (732) 431-7160 or send a letter to 132 Jerseyville Ave, Freehold, NJ 07728.
